## 3. Principal's Report/Admin Update (Jason Rodman):

- COVID-19 - We have had an increase in student and staff self reported cases. We continue to share this information with our school community via email. Families are encouraged to share positive results. Students and families are asked to follow the student screener daily. If families have questions about a scenario, they are encouraged to call the office for clarification. If necessary, we can reach out to our Public Health Nurse or the DDSB Health \& Safety department.
- EQAO - Grade 3\&6 will complete the standardized assessments the last week of May and first week of June. This year the assessment will be online, and students will complete it on Chromebooks. Once more information is available, it will be shared directly with grade $3 \& 6$ families. Grade 3 (Mary 30-June 3), Grade 6 (June 6-10)
- FDK Pen - Basketball nets - We sent a message to the Early Years department, requesting to have basketball nets put on the wall in the Kindergarten pen. We were advised by Facilities Services that we are not allowed to fasten the nets to the walls. We will look into purchasing portable basketball nets. Facility Services has visited the school and having contractors examine our parking lot drainage. We are strongly advocating to have a drain basin added near the West Kindergarten entry gate.
- Track \& Field- This year the Board will not be hosting a Track \& Field Area meet. Our school will be doing a Junior/Intermediate field day at the school. This will be planned for late May/June.
- Extra Curricular - Our Intermediate Boys basketball is finishing the season and Junior Boys basketball is starting next week. Thank you to Mr. St. John for coaching. Ms. Stanko will be starting a Junior/Intermediate Basketball school league starting next week. Our Intermediate band continues to practice during class and will be preforming at Canada's Wonderland in June.
- Graduation - We are excited to host an in-person event on June 21. More details will be provided to our graduates and families soon.
- Trustee Visit - We were pleased to host our Trustee and Chair of the Board, Carolyn Morton with our Superintendent, Erin Elmhurst last week.
- Kiss \& Ride - We continue to have several families not using our Kiss \&Ride. We have had an increase in families parking on Front Street and entering the North Parking lot with the school busses. We continue to post our signs, have additional staff in the parking lot as well as contacting the Township of Uxbridge Bylaw Officer. Families are asked to use Kiss \& Ride or to park on Lapier Street during dismissal.
